2. Thread Bobbin (one with flared ceramic tip is least frustrating)
3. Bodkin
4. FINE point scissors

1. Threads- (Brown, Black, Tan, Olive in Size 6/0
2. Dubbing- (Brown, Black, Tan, Olive)
3. Hackle Feathers- (Small Packs of 100s in Grizzly, Brown, Light Dun)
4. Maribou - (Brown, Black, Tan, Olive)
5. Chenille- (Size Small in Brown, Black, Tan, Olive)
6. Deer Hair and Elk Hair
7. Hooks - (For Trout = Sizes 10-12-14-16, For Streamers = Sizes 6-8-10)
8. Head Cement

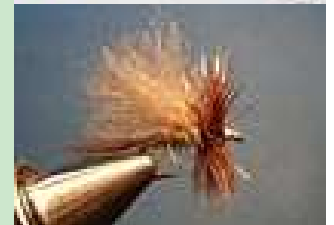
Books: (Third is excellent but expensive, optional)
